Standard Operating Guideline Uniform

SOG 003

3.01 In order to maintain uniformity and present a professional appearance no member is to purchase any uniform item with district identifiers without prior approval of the Chief. The Chief may review any such requests with the District Commissioners if necessary. Badges, emblems and other official uniform items shall be provided by the district.

3.02 Class B

SHIRT: Light blue with military creases for firefighters and officers, Chief and Deputy Chief may wear the same style shirt in white. Badge over left breast pocket; name pin over the right breast pocket; recognized Fire Department patch two fingers down from the crown on the left shoulder sleeve; American flag patch two fingers down from the crown on the right shoulder sleeve unless an EMT or First Responder patch is required in that position. Other patches, pins, or adornments may be allowed if approved by the Chief.

JACKET: Jacket will be supplied by the District in order to maintain uniformity. The jacket may be worn casually so as to be identified on an emergency scene.

PANTS: Navy blue slacks are preferred but good clean jeans are acceptable.

HAT: An approved, baseball-type hat may be worn with the uniform as an option.

3.03 Informal or Duty

SHIRT: Light blue with military creases for firefighters and officers, Chief and Deputy Chief may wear the same style shirt in white. Badge over left breast pocket; name pin over the right breast pocket; recognized Fire Department patch two fingers down from the crown on the left shoulder sleeve; American flag patch two fingers down from the crown on the right shoulder sleeve unless an EMT or First Responder patch is required in that position. Other patches, pins, or adornments may be allowed if approved by the Chief.

T-SHIRT: Navy T-Shirt as supplied by the District

PANTS: Navy blue duty pants or good clean denim jeans.

SWEATSHIRT: As supplied by the district or approved by the Chief.

HAT: An approved, baseball-type hat may be worn with the uniform as an option.
